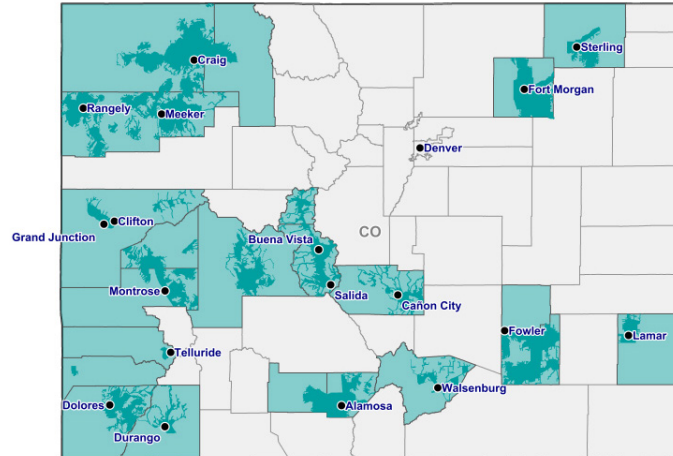

- Technological innovations are developed, integrated and tested at the *Charter Technology and Engineering Center (CTEC)*, located in the Compaq Business Park in Douglas County. The CTEC houses approximately **200** employees in an **85,000** square-foot, state-of-the-art facility.
- Charter has signed a long-term lease on a new **12-story, 306,000** square-foot facility in Greenwood Village with a planned occupancy of **1,600** by 2018. This new Charter office building represents a multi-million dollar investment in the Denver community and is providing a modernized, eco-friendly workplace for employees.
